# Petronet planning 5 mtpa LNG terminal in Bangladesh – reports

Indian oil and gas firm Petronet is looking to build a 5 mtpa LNG import terminal at Kutubdia Island in southeast Bangladesh, according to local news reports citing company CEO Prabhat Singh.

The new terminal would be built in the same location as the proposed 3.5 mtpa Bangla LNG import terminal, local media reported on Thursday. Petronet was short-listed for the construction of Bangla LNG at the end of 2014.
