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PNG LNG goes above and beyond in Q1, paving way for spot market sales

The Papua New Guinea LNG plant exceeded its 6.9 mtpa nameplate capacity by 1.4 mtpa over the first three months of 2017, according to facility part-owner Oil Search.

“2017 first quarter production of 7.57 million boe was one of the highest quarterly outputs ever achieved by the company,” Oil Search managing director Peter Botten said in a quarterly results statement.



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
