INTERVIEW: Li Yao, founder and CEO of SIA Energy

Earlier this month, Gas Matters' sister publication LNG Business Review examined the challenge China's three NOCs – PetroChina, Sinopec and CNOOC – face digesting the huge volumes of LNG they have committed to. Indeed, while China's latest five-year plans indicate an increasing emphasis on gas as part of the country's energy mix, the country's clumsy mix of central control and market mechanisms may have unintended consequences.
