Qatari LNG exports ‘not affected by Gulf diplomatic crisis’ – experts

Qatari exports of LNG are unlikely to be affected by the unfolding crisis triggered by Saudi Arabia and its allies cutting diplomatic and economic ties with the Gulf Arab peninsular state – barring an escalation of the situation.

Regional experts told Gas Matters Today that the LNG exports heading eastwards to India and the rest of Asia should be able to continue as normal, despite Saudi Arabia, Egypt, United Arab Emirates and Bahrain severing transport connections with Qatar amid claims of support for terrorist networks and links to Iran.
