BHGE to tackle gas flaring in Iraq with NGL plant

Iraq's central government has awarded a contract to oilfield service provider BHGE to install a natural gas liquids (NGL) plant that will help recover flared gas at the country's Nassiriya and Al Gharraf oil fields.

BHGE, formed after the recent merger of Baker Hughes and General Electric Oil and Gas, has agreed to develop the plant, which will be located at Nassiriya, in two stages.
