Triumph Offshore, a subsidiary of India's Swan Energy, has contracted South Korea's Hyundai Heavy Industries to build a 180,000 cm LNG floating storage and re-gasification Unit (FSRU) for its LNG regasification project in Gujarat, northwest India.

Swan is moving forward with its 2008 plans to launch India's first FSRU based LNG terminal at Jafrabad in Gujarat with a total capacity of 5 mtpa.
