The decision by ExxonMobil and BHP to stop jointly marketing gas from the Gippsland Basin Joint Venture (GBJV) is a public relations victory for Australia's competition watchdog (ACCC), which called for the break-up in a bid to lower spiralling retail gas prices in southern states.
