China's dependence on higher-priced (relative to domestically produced gas) oil-linked gas imports surged from visual_editor% in visual_editor006 to 3visual_editor% in visual_editor013. This growing dependence has put pressure on the government for further domestic gas price hikes and reform of the gas pricing regime to incentivise further imports (of both LNG and pipeline). Gas Strategies considers the impact of China's ongoing gas price reforms on market fundamentals, and the implications for LNG.



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
