Sasol production in Mozambique offsets declines in Canada

South Africa-based Sasol has increased production and sales from its Mozambique wells over the past year, but failed to increase output in Canada, the company said in its latest operations report.

Production and external sales from Canadian wells declined 5% year on year to 20.7 Bcf (586 MMcm) between June 2015 and June 2016. The company holds a 50% working interest in two gas fields in British Columbia.
