Consortium to build world's largest LPG-fuelled CCGT in Ghana

Ghana has approved an international consortium to build a 400 MW CCGT equipped to burn LPG, gas or diesel, which will become the largest plant of its kind in the world and the only one located in Africa.

Partner companies GE, trading company Sage Petroleum and utility firm Endeavor Energy plan to install the Bridge Power project in the port city of Tema in two stages, the first bringing 194 MW online and a second stage adding 206 MW.
