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Shell mulls Gabon offshore gas field divestment after offloading onshore assets

Shell is understood to be looking at selling its two licences offshore Gabon – including a "substantial" but unquantified gas find – after striking a deal to sell its entire onshore portfolio in the African country.

Both licences are up for review as part of Shell's broader USD 30 billion divestment programme but no decision has yet been taken, a well-placed source told Gas Matters Today.







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
