Iran ends reliance on erratic Turkmen gas with pipeline to northern provinces

Iran has inaugurated the Damghan-Neka pipeline to supply gas to provinces around the Caspian Sea and in north of the country that for the last 20 years have relied on faltering flows from neighbouring Turkmenistan.

Construction of the pipeline dragged on for 10 years until Iran's Minister of Petroleum Bijan Zangeneh ordered a speedy completion, prompted by Turkmenistan halting supplies on January 1.

Turkmenistan demanded that Iran pay more for the supplies and settle a disputed USD 2 billion debt accumulated during ...
