Cheniere talks tough on GAIL as Sabine Pass Train 4 hits first LNG

Cheniere Energy has sought to play down reports that India's state-owned utility GAIL is seeking to renegotiate a 20-year 3.5 mtpa contract with the US exporter.

Cheniere CEO Jack Fusco took a tough line during a Q2'17 earnings call, telling investors: "A contract is a contract and that's been our position with all our customers".

Fusco added that his company "intends to meet all of our contractual obligations... and in return, we expect our customers to ...
