France is back peddling on its proposal to cut nuclear's share of the power mix from 75% to 50% by 2025, after the country's grid operator RTE warned the plan risked power shortages after 2020, in addition to increasing CO2 emissions, with 11 GW of gas-fired plants required to help fill the void.
